The Nature Conservancy is submitting this letter in support of the extension of time (EOT) request submitted by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service on June 13, 2013. This request would extend the deadline for submitting comments on the Proposed Study Plans (PSP) for the Wilder (FERC No. 1892-026), Bellows Falls (FERC No. 1855-045), Vernon (FERC No. 1904-073), and Turners Falls (FERC No. 1889-081) hydroelectric projects, and the Northfield Mountain Pumped Storage Project (FERC No. 2485-063) from July 15, 2013 to July 30, 2013.

The Nature Conservancy finds that this is a reasonable request given the extent and complexity of the PSPs, the forthcoming provision of revised materials by the licensees, and the additional meetings and site visits scheduled in coming weeks.
