### Dear Secretary Bose:

TransCanada Hydro Northeast Inc. ("TransCanada") is the owner and licensee of the Wilder Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1892), the Bellows Falls Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1855), and the Vernon Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1904). The current licenses for these projects each expire on April 30, 2018. On October 31, 2012, TransCanada initiated the Integrated Licensing Process by filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC" or "Commission") its Notice of Intent to seek new licenses for each project, along with a separate Pre-Application Document for each project.

TransCanada submitted its Revised Study Plan for the three projects, as required by 18 C.F.R. §5.15(c)(1) on August 14, 2013. In accordance with Revised Study 33-Cultural and Historic Resources Study, enclosed please find the following reports for your review and comment:

• Phase IB Archaeological Identification Survey, Wilder Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1892-026), Bellows Falls Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1855-

045), and Vernon Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1904-073), Orange, Windham, and Windsor Counties, Vermont.

• Phase IB Archaeological Identification Survey, Wilder Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1892-026), Bellows Falls Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1855-045), Vernon Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1904-073), Cheshire, Grafton and Sullivan Counties, New Hampshire.

The enclosed reports were also sent to the Vermont and New Hampshire State Historic Preservation Offices (respectively) and to the Narragansett Indian Tribe and The Nolumbeka Project Inc., as indicated by the attached transmittal letters.

On September 14, 2015 the Commission issued a Revised Process Plan and Schedule for the Connecticut River Projects that identified March 1, 2016 as a "target" filing deadline for Updated Study Reports on studies yet to be completed. Any remaining study reports that could not be filed by March 1, 2016 would be identified along with a respective filing date. In its March 1, 2016 Updated Study Report, TransCanada included: ten final study reports and supporting data; three interim study reports; a schedule for completing and filing the remaining study reports; and, proposed comment period deadlines with the understanding that FERC will make the final determination on formal comment deadlines.

TransCanada has recommended a comment period until July 15, 2016 for final study reports filed between March 2 and May 15, 2016, which includes the enclosed Phase IB Archaeological Identification Surveys.
