Dear Mr. Ragonese:

Great River Hydro, LLC (Great River) filed relicense applications for the Wilder Hydroelectric Project No. 1892, Bellows Falls Hydroelectric Project No. 1855, and Vernon Hydroelectric Project No. 1904 on May 1, 2017, and amended the applications on December 7, 2020.

By letter filed on February 3, 2022, Great River stated that it has been engaged in productive settlement discussions with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, the New Hampshire Department of Fish and Game, and the Vermont Department of Fish and Wildlife to address fish passage issues at each of the projects. Great River stated that it expected to file an executed settlement agreement on fish passage in February 2022.

The amended license applications have been pending for over nineteen months, and Great River has not filed a settlement agreement or an update on the status of the agreement since the February 3 letter. Within 15 days from the date of this letter, please provide an update on Great River's progress in reaching a settlement agreement and a schedule for filing the settlement agreement.
